I. Brief biographical data about the candidate

Chief assistant d-r Penka Vulcheva is a sole candidate in the Competitive Procedure. She graduated from 'Prof. d-r Assen Zlatarov 'Universuty, Burgasmajoring in Preschool and Elementary School Pedagogy (2010). In 2012 she obtained her master degree in 'Preschool and Elementary School Pedagogy' in the same university, Faculty of Social Sciences, specialising in 'Alternative Pedagogical Techniques in Preschool and Elementary School'.

The candidate worked as teacher in elementary school in 'Burgas' Private School in the period of September 15. 2016 to May 31. 2017, and as teacher in 'Budeshte' Private School, Plovdiv from 10.10 2013 to 05. 31. From 06. 01. 2017 to 03. 23. 2018 she worked as a teacher in 'Zlatnoto Kluche' Kindergarten, Burgas.

In 2017, the candidate defended her dissertation 'Development of Communicative Competence through Creative Narrative in Preschool Group 'and obtained PhD degree (doctoral programme 'Methodology of Bulgarian language and Literature Teaching' in 'Paisii Hilendarski' University, Plovdiv.

The submitted certificates testify to a serious scientific interest, in particular the training course in Norway on 'Social Innovations', which directly corresponds to the subject of the candidate's dissertation.

In 2018, after a successfully passed Competition Application Procedure, she started work as assistant at 'Prof. d-r. Assen Zlatarov' University, Burgas, Department of 'Methodology of Pedagogical Education', where she holds seminars and training practice on Methodology of Bulgarian language and Literature Teaching in preschool and elementary school.

Since 10. 19. 2020, d-r Penka Vulcheva has been giving lectures and seminar practice as chief assistant at the same university.

II.Overview of the scientific and scientifically applied work of the candidate

From the minimal national requirements reference (Final Provisions on the Academic Staff Development Regulations, issued in STATE JOURNAL, copy 56/2018) for holding the academic position of associate professor, can be seen that the scientific work of chief assistant d-r Penka Vulcheva is above the minimum group index as follows: group A- 50 points (required 50), group B- 100 points (required 100), group G- 422,5 (required 200), group D-95 points (required-50), group E-110 points (no minimum requirement). A reference for additional index performance has also been submitted: on-line and attendance lecture courses- 5; participation in international scientific forums abroad -2; university scientific and research forums-2; published university textbook on Theory and Methodology of Bulgarian language Teaching in preschool (co-authored) and a university teaching aid (co-authored). The developed and published co-authored Pastar Sviat' teaching aids for the elementary school system, together with the respective teachers' books, are considered a great achievement.

While evaluating chief assistant d-r Vulcheva's contribution, I will take into consideration her entire scientific work, but I will review her postdoctoral period only.

III. Main contributions of the scientific, scientifically applied and teaching activity of the candidate:

For participation in the competition, chief assistant Penka Vulcheva has submitted a monography, a book based on defended dissertation, one textbook and one university teaching aid (both co-authored), 2 teaching aids for preschool education practice(co-authored) and 17 publications- one co-authored. 4 of the publications are from participation in scientific forums.

elementary school literature teaching technology. She proves that the systematic and consecutive use of the mnemonic technique in the process of perceiving lyrical works is a determinative factor for comprehension and recreation of the studied piece. A complete two-way system has been created, which demonstrates how the teacher reorganises the cognitive content, interprets it and transforms it into systematic visual structure, which enables the child to follow the process of comprehension at their own pace and rhythm. Chief assistant d-r Vulcheva's contribution to the development of a pedagogical-technological model, focusing on students' learning how to prepare and apply mental cards and tables in the process of teaching pedagogical interaction, is very creative and innovative. This method is both creative and emotionally attractive, because it relies on the student's own activity. This contribution is particularly significant, because preschool children perceive the creation of these images and simplified pictures as mental card game

In her postdoctoral period, chief assistant d-r Vulcheva persists in her endeavours to develop her ideas about creative retelling and its psycho-pedagogical projections. The book, based on her dissertation work, presents an approbated technological model for developing children's communicative skills in preschool groups

The elaborated technological model has been specified in a number of articles. The use of visual props (mental cards and simple images), and key words used as props, is in the context of the gradual winding of the creative narrative, in accordance with the formed three-stage correlation 'speech-thinking-imagination'.

Chief assistant Vulcheva's contributions in the field of methodology of native language teaching comprise various themes and subjects and relate both to theory and practice (co-authored). Main pedagogical concepts of the teaching context, the methods and teaching techniques and possibilities for inner verbal activity motivation are methodologically determined. The role of the game technique, concerning the summarising function of the word is logically substantiated in an article.

Another group of publications focus on the continuity of Bulgarian language teaching in preschool and elementary school on the basis of interactive methods. Apart from the 'reading and writing' preparation process, all opportunities for mastering reading in preschool are also argued. A parallel has been drawn between perceiving a fairy tale and a fable in both institutions, and creating a narrative based on a text excerpt.

IV. Contribution significance

The theoretical contributions of the candidate have been experimentally explored and proven.

- Contribution to the methodology of the native language teaching as part of the teacher's professional competence.
- The methodological system for the development of children's creative narrative has been expanded.
- Theoretical and methodological paradigm for mental cards application in the literary education of preschool children has been introduced.
- Programme content model has been developed,
 primarily related to language acquisition and speech development in preschool.

The practice-applied contributions of the candidate are both in the sphere of the student's practical education and preschool education.

Precisely structured pedagogical technique has been designed, approbated and introduced into practice, which is intended for the formation of pedagogical students' professional competence for work with mnemonic tables in the process of literary education in preschool.

- A pedagogical-technological pattern for creating mental cards
 has been developed and a practically -applied algorithm for their use in
 the process of pedagogical interaction has been designed.
- Chief assistant d-r Vulcheva's scientific work can be defined as an example of perfect uniformity between theory and practice. She demonstrates an ability to operationalise theoretical production to a

verified transfer into practice. Native language education in preschool is assisted by an approbated pedagogical technique.

- All papers submitted by chief assistant d-r Penka Vulcheva meet the requirements of the Law of Academic Staff Development in Republic of Bulgaria, the regulations for its implementation and the respective Rules of Procedure of 'Prof. d-r Assen Zlatarov' University
- The number of the submitted papers published after the candidate's dissertation is sufficient and focus on the methodological education of the students from the pedagogical disciplines and the actual pedagogical practice.

V. There is no plagiarism or violated author's rights in the submitted papers

VI. Teaching practice

Chief assistant d-r Vulcheva gives lectures and holds seminars in 'Methodology of Bulgarian Language and Literature Teaching in Preschool' attendance and on-line education (Zoom, Teams), bachelor degree, distant and full-time education; Methodology of Bulgarian language and Literature in Elementary School'; 'Comparative Education'. She also trains students in 'Literature Teaching to Bilingual Children', 'Cinematic pedagogy', Cinema Art and Literary Education', 'Inclusive Education', 'Preschool Pedagogy'. She has also supervised pre-graduation internship of students majoring in 'Preschool Pedagogy with Foreign Language' and 'Elementary School Pedagogy with foreign language'.

VII. Critical notes and recommendations

My main critical comment is that the articles in the sphere of native language teaching in preschool predominate, in comparison with the publications concerning elementary school education. The candidate should continue her research in the sphere of Bulgarian language and Literature Methodology and intensify her

endeavours in search of ways to implement innovative methodological ideas into practice

Conclusion

The evaluation of chief assistant d-r Vulcheva's scientific work and teaching activity proves: adequate scientific priorities, qualitative correlation between the scientific work and the scientific metric criteria and indexes, positive contribution of the submitted papers, applicability of results.

Based on all the above, I can fully claim that the submitted scientific publications and the scientific and practical experience of the candidate give me full grounds to advise the members of the esteemed Scientific Jury to propose to the Department Council of the Faculty of Social Sciences at 'Prof. d-r Asen Zlatarov' University to elect chief assistant PhD Penka Vulcheva as Associate Professor in professional direction 1.2 Pedagogy- Methodology of Bulgarian Language and Literature Teaching in preschool and elementary school, at 'Prof. d-r Asen Zlatarov' University.
